







Live Session Agreement










We will be inviting all children to take part in live sessions with their class teacher and teaching assistant.

To ensure that everyone stays safe online please could you make sure that you and your child/children follow the instructions in our Live Session Agreement.










If a child's behaviour is not in line with the school behaviour expectations, the incident will be dealt with appropriately.

	Make sure an adult is in the room during the live session to support with active listening and engagement.
	Choose a place that is comfortable and quiet. For example a place that is away from television and electronic distractions.
	When you log in to a live session, turn your audio off/mute the sound. If you are asked to answer any questions you will be directed to turn the sound back on.
	Check that your background is clear of any personal items you do not wish to share with the community.
	Make sure you are dressed appropriately as you would be coming to school or seeing your friends outside of your house.
	Remember, you will be seen by everyone on camera so "be the best that you can be".
