Dear Parents and Carers

Welcome to the start of the new academic year! We are so excited to welcome you and your children back to school and to begin another year of learning and growth together. We hope you've all had a wonderful and relaxing summer break.

This new school year starts on **Wednesday 3 September at 8:45 am**. We'd like to remind you of a few important details to ensure a smooth start for everyone.

Getting to Your Classroom

This year, all children should enter the school through the main school gate. The only exception is for children in Packham and Thunberg classes, who should use the gate leading to the small playground as they have done previously. Teachers will be at the classroom door to meet children.

Nursery: Enter through the Nursery Gate

Reception and Year 1: Enter through the Reception playground gate and drop off at the classroom door

Year 2: Teachers will be in the playground to meet you - make your way to the main hall doors and children will line up in their classes

Year 3 and Year 4: Enter through the main hall doors

Year 5 Farah and Year 5 Simmonds classes: Enter through the doors to the Year 5 Hub

Year 5 Ennis and Year 6 classes: Enter through the Year 5/6 Hub

Staff will be present in the playground to provide support and directions.
