Ark Farm Visit to EYFS

Nursery and Reception had a visit from Ark Farm this half term. We met a gecko, mouse, hairless guinea pig, chicks, a hedgehog, sugar gliders and chinchillas. We were able to touch and learn about these animals with adult supervision. We also got to touch and feed rabbits, guinea pigs and a tortoise! This was an amazing experience for the children as we have been learning about animals and their habitats. The learning didn't stop when the animals left! Back in their classrooms, the children had great fun talking about their experiences. They used their descriptive words to explain how the animals felt, what they looked like, and what they like to eat.



Learning in Reception

We have been learning how to bake in class, making shortbread biscuits and decorating other biscuits for our school Eid celebration. We were very lucky to have the fire brigade visit us for our topic on 'People who help us'. We had an exciting time exploring the engine, sitting in the cab and seeing all the equipment. In maths, we have been learning about doubling numbers and odd and even numbers. We are getting our outside area ready for planting seeds and bulbs for summer. We planted a pea seed and have been watching it grow. Our still life drawings of a daffodil helped us with our observational skills. To finish our very busy half term, we had an Easter Egg Hunt in our garden, finding the egg we had decorated and receiving an egg to take home as a reward for our hard work!

Year 1 Mother's Day Stay and Play and Animal Workshop

It was a joy to welcome so many mums, grandmothers, aunts and siblings into our classrooms. These special sessions gave our families a wonderful chance to spend quality time together and join in with some creative crafts.

Our Year 1 budding scientists enjoyed a very special visit from Gabi at Animal Aid this week. Through an interactive workshop, the children explored the essential 'must-haves' for our furry and feathered friends, linking perfectly with our Science topic on Comparing Animals. From discussing nutritious diets to safe habitats, the children applied their scientific knowledge to learn exactly what it takes to keep a pet happy and healthy.



Rainbow Class

On World Book Day, pupils in Rainbow class enjoyed stepping outside in our outdoor area with a book in hand. They all found a comfortable spot whilst the year 2 pupils read to the year 1 pupils celebrating books by simply connecting and reading together. Rainbow class pupils also had fun with their D&T lesson. The year 2 pupils made a moving monster by making linkages by connecting levers and pivots, whilst the Year 1 pupils made hand puppets. They made a great effort in learning to sew and understanding that 'joining technique' means connecting two pieces of fabric together.

Pupil Leadership and Sustainability: A Visit to the Eco Park

Our Sustainability Champions recently represented Chesterfield on a fantastic trip to the Eco Park. They joined pupil leaders from across our Trust schools to learn how we can all help protect our environment.

The children took part in interactive workshops to see exactly what happens to our household waste. They followed the journey of recyclable materials to see how they are:

- Collected from our homes.
- Sorted by large, clever machines.
- Distributed to be turned into something brand new!

As school leaders, the children will now bring these important messages back to their own classrooms. This experience helped them understand how small changes at home and school can make a big difference for our planet.

We are very proud of how well our student leaders represented Chesterfield alongside their peers from other schools.

Our next project will be to take part in a whole-school switch-off on Earth Day on 22 April!



Year 4 visit to National Gallery

Our Year 4 pupils recently enjoyed a fantastic trip to the National Gallery in London. This was a wonderful opportunity for the children to see famous paintings in real life and explore one of the most important art museums in the world.

Attendance

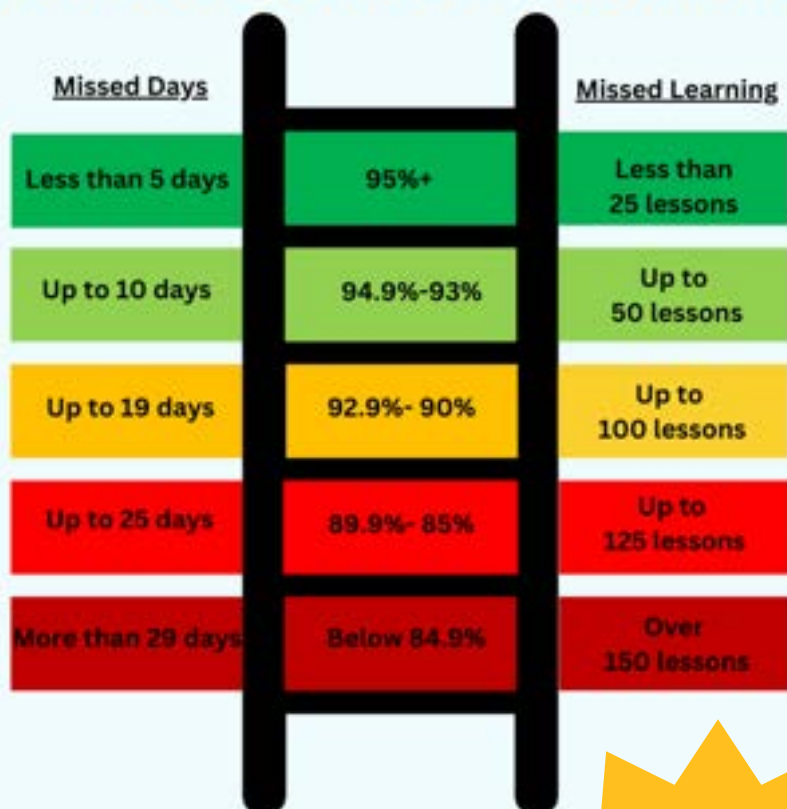
