These all had morals.</p> <p>Read Pandora's box and discuss with someone what the moral of the story is? Why did the myths all have morals? What can we learn from these?</p>	<p>The Parthenon was a famous Greek temple and was built in the Doric style of architecture.</p> <p>Research what it looked like, and then build your own version of it – use any materials you wish!</p>	<p>The Ancient Greeks had their own alphabet.</p> <p>Teach two people to spell and say their name using this alphabet.</p> <p>Did you have any problems with this?
